**Prior GSU Engagements:****March 16-17, 2016 – Kadir Has University Visit**

Georgia State University welcomed administrators from Kadir Has University (Istanbul, Turkey) on March 16-17 for exploratory discussions on innovative programs, research collaborations, and faculty and student exchange programs with the College of Law, International Initiatives, the Robinson College of Business and faculty members from Georgia State's Turkey Force.

Mustafa Aydin, president of Kadir Has University, and Sinem Acikmese, associate professor of international relations and coordinator of the International Collaboration and Education office, met with the colleges and faculty members and signed an agreement with Georgia State Law's LL.M. Program for Foreign-Trained Lawyers.

Volkan Topalli, acting associate provost for international initiatives, and his staff shared a number of innovative programs and projects organized by the university, and furthered discussions to engage Kadir Has students and faculty to enroll in Georgia State's Summer Institute and Faculty Mentoring Program, respectively.

Steven J. Kaminshine, dean of the College of Law, and Aydin signed a program specific agreement (PSA) for a specialized LL.M. program for Kadir Has graduates. The agreement establishes a partnership where up to five Kadir Has graduates will be accepted into the college's LL.M. program each year.
