ABOUT THE PROGRAM

During Summer Sessions, participants spend two weeks engaging in field-based seminars and exploring two distinctly different U.S. cities, Atlanta, Georgia and Pensacola, Florida. Participants also get the opportunity to spend time with Georgia State students for a chance to learn about what life is like for locals.

INTRODUCTORY BIOLOGY AND ENGLISH LANGUAGE

Participants will learn various aspects of biology research including some of the latest, cutting-edge technologies that are used in molecular biological research today. Also, they will visit the Museum at the Centers for Disease Control & Prevention headquarters showcasing public health history. Participants will have the chance to partake in culture and language sessions with Georgia State University students to learn about common customs and speech in the U.S.
