Georgia State University is located in dynamic downtown Atlanta, offering students an attractive opportunity to live and study in a city rich in diversity, history, commerce, entertainment, and more.

ABOUT THE PROGRAM

During Summer Sessions, participants spend two weeks engaging in field-based seminars and exploring two distinctly different U.S. cities, Atlanta, Georgia and Pensacola, Florida. Participants also get the opportunity to spend time with Georgia State students for a chance to learn about what life is like for locals.

INTRODUCTORY CHEMISTRY AND ENGLISH LANGUAGE

Chemistry seminars are designed to introduce the techniques of IR, ¹H-NMR, ¹³C-NMR, and mass spectrometry as powerful tools for structure elucidation in organic chemistry. Also, students will visit the Museum at the Centers for Disease Control & Prevention headquarters showcasing public health history. Participants will have the chance to partake in culture and language sessions with Georgia State University students to learn about common customs and speech in the U.S.

HOUSING AND MEALS
